

Village Awarded State Grant to Build Multi-Purpose Creek Trail

As a result of our Local Waterfront Revitalization Plan, the Village of Schoharie submitted and has been awarded a grant for \$380,000 to build a Schoharie Creek access and a multi-purpose trail. When complete it will:

- + Go 1.75 miles the Depot Lane area, along the creek, to Bridge Street
- + Have at least one creek access site for canoe and kayak use
- + Include a pedestrian bridge to the "Island" owned by the Schoharie Land Trust
- + Have parking at both ends of the trail
- + Link with sidewalks
- + Include bike racks

The multi-use trail is one of several other projects proposed in the Plan. Others that the Village will be working on in the future include improvements at Fox Creek Park, a neighborhood park at the old fire house site on Grand Street, and a pocket park near Sunset Dr.

It is hoped construction on the trail can begin in the summer of 2017. Stay tuned for more information on this exciting project.
